MARDI GRAS 2022 HONORS DR. ELIAS TARAKJI

For more than two decades of dedication and philanthropic efforts on behalf of Methodist Hospital, we proudly honor Elias Tarakji, MD, as the King of Mardi Gras.

"I first joined the medical staff in the Fall of 1999, and have enjoyed 24 great years at Methodist Hospital," Tarakji said. "When I first came to the San Gabriel Valley, I had privileges at 13 hospitals from Upland to Pasadena. Five years later, I only had privileges at Methodist Hospital because the hospital, the medical staff and the community were very welcoming."

Dr. Tarakji says has learned a great deal from his colleagues during his time at the hospital, especially Chief Medical Officer Bala Chandrasekhar, MD, as well as neurosurgeon and Stroke Program Medical Director Greg Withers, MD.

"Dr. Chandrasekhar has always been my mentor. I learned so much from Dr. Chandrasekhar and Dr. Withers. Both are very courageous and tough, and both emphasize that nothing compromises providing high quality patient care," he said.

Over time, Dr. Tarakji has become more involved with leadership roles at the hospital, first in the Department of Medicine and eventually became the Chief of Staff of the medical center in 2016. Upon completion of this term, he was asked to join the Hospital Board of Directors by Hospital President and CEO Dan Ausman.

"I've been privileged to serve as a board member and bring to the board the medical staff point of view, the physician's point of view, the patient's point of view as well as the viewpoint of support staff with whom I have direct contact," Dr. Tarakji said. "Last year I became the chair of the Board of Directors Quality Improvement (QI) Committee. This has been a learning process and a very nice way to positively affect how medical care is delivered at the hospital."

Working with the QI Committee has also been difficult at times to say the least because of COVID-19. "It has been a very challenging time during the pandemic," Dr. Tarakji said, quipping that Dr. Chandrasek-har described it "as being on an airplane 30,000 feet in the air and learning how to fly the plane at the same time."

"Staffing challenges, new procedures to follow, new standards and best practices affecting quality of care, and caring for a tremendous volume of patients and their families made this a very tough time," he said. "But we came out stronger and better as a hospital team, and I feel as though we are better prepared for surprises going forward."

With the pandemic subsiding, Dr. Tarakji looks forward to getting back to the typical routine with his medical practice and the hospital, which includes supporting fundraising events like Mardi Gras.

"Our facility's physical structure is appealing and inviting. Although it's a community hospital, the hospital has a great reputation for attracting patients from the entire the San Gabriel Valley and even surrounding counties."

The delivery of healthcare services has changed enormously in recent years. Lives that once would have been lost can now be saved. Procedures that could only be dreamed of are performed routinely. All this is possible at Methodist Hospital because of our loyal donors. You have provided us means to acquire the latest equipment and attract the medical expertise needed to save lives every day.

At tonight's Mardi Gras celebration, we emphasize the importance of furthering our mission. Our hospital has served the community for 119 years, and we want to ensure the success of our hospital's future in the decades to come. While our services were pushed to the limit by the COVID-19 pandemic, the community came through and supported us during this time of need.

As we continue to move forward, we look to your help to address the need for emerging technologies.

We are moving forward with the purchase of a new da Vinci surgical robotic system. With the da Vinci robot, your surgeon is still with you in the operating room, seated at the robotic system console. The console gives surgeons control of the instruments used to perform your surgery. The robotic system offers 3D high-definition views and offers a crystal clear view of the surgical area that is magnified 10 times to what the human eye sees. In addition, the surgeon uses tiny instruments that move like a human hand, but with a far greater range of motion with smooth precision. Surgery conducted using a da Vinci surgical robotic system is less invasive, produces shorter hospital stays, and can lead to quicker recovery times and better outcomes for patients.

In addition, we are developing plans to construct a Hybrid Operating Room, which combines a traditional operating room with an image guided interventional suite. This combination allows for highly complex, advanced surgical procedures. Hybrid operating rooms are used in cardiac surgery, vascular and endovascular surgery, as well, as in neurological and spinal surgery. Intraoperative imaging to perform and assure the quality in complex surgeries plays a central role in this.

The addition of both of these innovative technologies will help continue the medical excellence offered by the experts at Methodist Hospital for years to come.




